

Rose Wilder Lane, whose mother wrote the **LITTLE HOUSE ON THE PRAIRIE** book series, is the author of **THE DISCOVERY OF FREEDOM**, one of the most fundamental statements ever published on **LIBERTY**. She points out that humans are seldom really able to recognize chaos and disaster until after they are immersed in it.
